

GENERAL RULES

- Everyday classes will start from 10.00 a.m. & will end at 5.30p.m. Students have to reach college within the scheduled time & cannot leave college without prior permission.
- Everyday students have to maintain their Uniform properly & have to wear their ID- Card during college hours; otherwise they will not be allowed to enter the college premise. In case, ID-Card is lost, that student has to issue a police diary & have to submit it to the college. Issuing of new ID-Card is chargeable
- Students have to maintain 80% of attendance in each semester for availing the facility of campusing. Students, who will get the scholarship, have to maintain Minimum 70% Marks in each Semester to retain their scholarship for rest of the period. Otherwise

- their scholarship will be cancelled.
- Students have to attend all the seminars, special lectures & Certification courses arranged by ECMT.
- Harming any of college property will be regarded as punishable offence. As Punishment College can suspend the guilty person or money will be charged.
- Labs & Library can be used only with permission. Without permission no one is allowed. Labs & Library have to be used with proper care. Any harm to these is punishable.
- Students found guilty in disobeying the rules of the college or with any inappropriate behavior will be subject of punishment. As punishment suspension or cancellation of registration will be in course of action.

HOSTEL RULES

- Students have to pay the Hostel fees in advance within 5th of every month; otherwise Rs. 1000/will be imposed as fine.
- Student cannot go out of the hostel without permission of college authority for any kind of personal need.
- Students have to return to the hostel within
 6.30 p.m. After that entry will be prosecuted.
- Whenever students move out from the hostel

- they have to put signature and other details in the Log Book at the main gate.
- Any Students or Students found guilty in any kind of misbehavior with roommate or others or found in indulging any kind of offensive addiction or found in harming a hostel property will be subjected suspension from Hostel as well as college.

Students will refrain from ragging of any kind and those who violate this rule will be instantly suspended from the college. The matter will be placed before the Anti- Ragging Committee, which will review the incident of ragging and take action according to the process of law. Students must take note that ragging results in their dismissal from college. The attention of the students is also drawn to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India wherein it is mandatory for the institution to file a complaint with the Police Authority, and with all resulting consequences as per "The Circular of the Education Department, Government of West Bengal on Prohibition of Ragging in Colleges and Hostel."

INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE

In pursuance of UGC (Prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher educational institutions) Regulations, 2015 read with Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 and in partial modification of Office Order No. 449 dated 05.08.2016, Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) is re-constituted as under to deal with the complaints relating to Sexual harassment at work place.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE

The Grievance Redressal Committee shall consider only individual grievances of specific nature of staff and students of the institute raised individually by the concerned aggrieved employee or student.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CELL

Emphasis to the deprived groups for learning and creating space for them to mainstream themselves will be the job of Equal Opportunity Cell which will run specific scheme of coaching for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, OBC (non-creamy layer), and Minorities in order to enhance the employability and success.
